 - 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
 - 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
 - 3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.
 - 4 This Act may be cited as the "No Taxpayer Funds
 - 5 for Illegal Immigrant Identity Cards Act".
 - 6 SEC. 2. PURPOSES.
 - 7 The purposes of this Act are—

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1 (1) to prohibit the Secretary of Homeland Secu2 rity from using Federal funds to establish the ICE
3 Secure Docket Card program or any other Federal
4 program that issues free identity cards to aliens who
5 are unlawfully present in the United States.

6 SEC. 3. PROHIBITIONS.

- 7 (a) ICE SECURE DOCKET CARD.—Notwithstanding
- 8 any other provision of law, no Federal funds may be used
- 9 to establish, implement, or otherwise support the activities
- 10 of the U.S. Immigration and Customs Enforcement Se-
- 11 cure Docket Card program or of any other similar pro-
- 12 gram of the Department of Homeland Security.
- 13 (b) Proof of Identification.—No documentation,
- 14 in any form, which was issued for the primary purpose
- 15 of providing access to information regarding the status of
- 16 an individual's immigration proceedings, may be used as
- 17 proof of identification for the purpose of establishing eligi-
- 18 bility for any Federal public benefit (as defined in section
- 19 401(c) of the Personal Responsibility and Work Oppor-
- 20 tunity Reconciliation Act of 1996 (8 U.S.C. 1611(c))).

21 **SEC. 4. REPORT.**

- Not later than 6 months after the date of enactment
- 23 of this Act, the Inspector General of the Department of
- 24 Homeland Security shall submit a report to the Committee
- 25 on Homeland Security and Governmental Affairs of the

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- 1 Senate and the Committee on Homeland Security of the
- 2 House of Representatives that describes the establish-
- 3 ment, operation, and any costs associated with the ICE
- 4 Secure Docket Card program or any other Federal pro-
- 5 gram that issues free identity cards to aliens who are un-
- 6 lawfully present in the United States.
